

HSUS investigates Kanawha Valley, Virginia, wildlife killing contest

Undercover investigation exposes cash-and-prizes game targeting coyotes and foxes





OVER A 45-HOUR PERIOD, participants in a wildlife killing contest in Dugspur, Virginia, gunned down approximately 315 coyotes and foxes for the chance at cash and prizes. Undercover investigators with the Humane Society of the United States witnessed the aftermath of the killing at the weigh-in located at the Kanawha Valley Arena Resort, which took place from Jan. 15-17, 2021. Participants in the Kanawha Valley Predator Calling Championship arrived and dragged bloody coyotes and foxes from their trucks to the weigh station. Judges awarded cash prizes to the teams that killed the most animals, and there were side pots for biggest coyote and biggest fox killed. First place went to a two-man team who killed 52 animals. At least 65 teams took part in the event.

Contests like this one are held across the state and target bobcats, coyotes and foxes. Virginia is home to one of the largest contests in the nation—the Eastern U.S. Predator Calling Championship—which invites people from all states east of the Mississippi River to participate and is next scheduled to take place in January 2022. Organizers call the contest a "family friendly event" and the "premier predator hunting event in the Eastern United States."

Fire departments, gun shops, sporting goods stores, fairgrounds and even churches have hosted or

organized these events in Virginia. Wildlife killing contests serve no legitimate wildlife management function. They can injure countless animals and orphan dependent young, who are left to die from starvation, predation or exposure. The contests do not reduce coyote numbers, prevent conflicts with farm animals, or boost populations of game species and the cruelty of these contests violates traditional hunting ethics. With competitors bringing in dead animals from other states, the contests can also promote the spread of parasites and other diseases.

Key investigative observations:

- Piles of bloodied animals packed into crates attached to trucks bearing stickers and license plates reading, "Coyote Hearse," "Coyote Taxi" and "Yote H8R," illustrating an attitude of total disregard for animal lives.
- Men dragging animals who had been ripped apart by bullets to a scale, where they were hung upside down for weighing in front of the crowd.
- A team of participants wearing matching "Nightlife Assassins" sweatshirts, standing next to their pile of dead animals while congratulating one another.
- Dozens of dead animals in line for weighing, strewn about on the ground with their mouths closed shut by zip-ties.

- Young children playing and watching as ripped-up, dead animals were weighed.
- Participant trucks with Virginia, North Carolina, and West Virginia tags.

Eight states—Maryland, Massachusetts, Vermont, Arizona, California, Colorado, Washington and New Mexico—have banned wildlife killing contests in the last several years. Five of these states did so through the state wildlife commissions.

- Animals may only be taken in the state of Virginia.
- All kills must be turned in between 12 PM 1 PM on the Sunday of each hunt.
- No trapping allowed, this includes leg traps, box traps, snares, conibear traps, and hook & line.
- NO WET ANIMALS ACCEPTED. Inclement weather may affect this rule, but no submerged animals will be accepted.
- Dogs are not allowed to aid in the hunting process.
- NO FROZEN ANIMALS WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.
- Dance's reserves the right to remove animals from the competition for which foul play is suspected.
